International Hat-trick for Flagship Wine

The flagship 2004 Howard Park Cabernet Sauvignon has continued its winning streak, collecting its third international Silver Medal for 2008 at the recent San Francisco International Wine Competition.

The award adds to the growing list of accolades received by Howard Park Wines in its 20 year history as a premium Cabernet producer.

Made from only the best fruit to an uncompromising standard, the wine was also awarded Silver Medals at prestigious international competitions, Concours Mondial de Bruxelles and the International Wine Challenge in London earlier this year. It was also awarded a prestigious Blue- Gold Medal at the 2008 Sydney International Wine Competition.
